

## SEPTEMBER SCRIPTURE – PSALM 1

- <sup>1</sup> Blessed is the man who walks  
not in the counsel of the ungodly,  
nor stands in the path of sinners,  
nor sits in the seat of the scornful;
- <sup>2</sup> But his delight is in the law of the LORD,  
and in His law he meditates day and night.
- <sup>3</sup> He shall be like a tree  
planted by the rivers of water,  
that brings forth its fruit in its season,  
whose leaf also shall not wither;  
and whatever he does shall prosper.
- <sup>4</sup> The ungodly are not so, but are like the chaff  
which the wind drives away.
- <sup>5</sup> Therefore the ungodly shall not stand  
in the judgment,  
nor sinners in the congregation of the  
righteous.
- <sup>6</sup> For the LORD knows the way of the righteous,  
but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

## OCTOBER SCRIPTURE – PSALM 8

- <sup>1</sup> O LORD, our Lord,  
how excellent is Your name in all the earth,  
Who have set Your glory above the heavens!
- <sup>2</sup> Out of the mouth of babes and nursing infants  
You have ordained strength,  
because of Your enemies,  
that You may silence the enemy and the avenger.
- <sup>3</sup> When I consider Your heavens,  
the work of Your fingers,  
the moon and the stars, which You have ordained,  
<sup>4</sup> what is man that You are mindful of him,  
and the son of man that You visit him?
- <sup>5</sup> For You have made him a little lower than the angels,  
and You have crowned him with glory and honor.
- <sup>6</sup> You have made him to have dominion over  
the works of Your hands;  
You have put all things under his feet,
- <sup>7</sup> All sheep and oxen--  
even the beasts of the field,  
<sup>8</sup> the birds of the air,  
and the fish of the sea  
that pass through the paths of the seas.
- <sup>9</sup> O LORD, our Lord,  
how excellent is Your name in all the earth!

## NOVEMBER SCRIPTURE – PSALM 34:1-11

- 1 I will bless the LORD at all times;  
His praise shall continually be in my mouth.
- 2 My soul shall make its boast in the LORD;  
the humble shall hear of it and be glad.
- 3 Oh, magnify the LORD with me,  
and let us exalt His name together.
- 4 I sought the LORD, and He heard me,  
and delivered me from all my fears.
- 5 They looked to Him and were radiant,  
and their faces were not ashamed.
- 6 This poor man cried out,  
and the LORD heard him,  
and saved him out of all his troubles.
- 7 The angel of the LORD encamps all around  
those who fear Him, and delivers them.
- 8 Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good;  
blessed is the man who trusts in Him!
- 9 Oh, fear the LORD, you His saints!  
There is no want to those who fear Him.
- 10 The young lions lack and suffer hunger; but  
those who seek the LORD shall not lack any  
good thing.
- 11 Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach  
you the fear of the LORD.

## DECEMBER SCRIPTURE – PSALM 19: 1, 7-14

- 1 The heavens declare the glory of God; and  
the firmament shows His handiwork.
- 7 The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the  
soul; the testimony of the LORD is sure,  
making wise the simple;
- 8 the statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing  
the heart; the commandment of the LORD is  
pure, enlightening the eyes;
- 9 the fear of the LORD is clean, enduring  
forever; the judgments of the LORD are true  
and righteous altogether.
- 10 More to be desired are they than gold,  
yea, than much fine gold; sweeter also than  
honey and the honeycomb.
- 11 Moreover by them Your servant is warned,  
and in keeping them there is great reward.
- 14 Let the words of my mouth and the  
meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your  
sight, O LORD, my strength and my  
Redeemer.

## JANUARY SCRIPTURE – PSALM 23

- <sup>1</sup> The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.
- <sup>2</sup> He makes me to lie down in green pastures;  
He leads me beside the still waters.
- <sup>3</sup> He restores my soul;  
He leads me in the paths of righteousness  
for His name's sake.
- <sup>4</sup> Yea, though I walk through the valley  
of the shadow of death,  
I will fear no evil;  
for You are with me;  
Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.
- <sup>5</sup> You prepare a table before me  
in the presence of my enemies;  
You anoint my head with oil;  
my cup runs over.
- <sup>6</sup> Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me  
all the days of my life;  
and I will dwell in the house of the LORD  
forever.

## PSALM 100

- <sup>1</sup> Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands!
- <sup>2</sup> Serve the LORD with gladness; Come before His  
presence with singing.
- <sup>3</sup> Know that the LORD, He is God; It is He who has  
made us,  
and not we ourselves; We are His people and the  
sheep of  
His pasture.
- <sup>4</sup> Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, And into His  
courts with  
praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name.
- <sup>5</sup> For the LORD is good; His mercy is everlasting. And  
His truth  
endures to all generations.

## FEBRUARY SCRIPTURE PSALM 103: 1-12

- <sup>1</sup> Bless the LORD, O my soul;  
and all that is within me, bless His holy name!
- <sup>2</sup> Bless the LORD, O my soul,  
and forget not all His benefits:
- <sup>3</sup> Who forgives all your iniquities,  
who heals all your diseases,
- <sup>4</sup> who redeems your life from destruction,  
who crowns you with loving kindness and  
tender mercies,
- <sup>5</sup> who satisfies your mouth with good things,  
so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.
- <sup>6</sup> The LORD executes righteousness  
and justice for all who are oppressed.
- <sup>7</sup> He made known His ways to Moses,  
His acts to the children of Israel.
- <sup>8</sup> The LORD is merciful and gracious,  
slow to anger, and abounding in mercy.
- <sup>9</sup> He will not always strive with us, nor will He keep His  
anger forever.
- <sup>10</sup> He has not dealt with us according to our sins,  
nor punished us according to our iniquities.
- <sup>11</sup> For as the heavens are high above the earth, so  
great is His mercy toward those who fear Him;
- <sup>12</sup> as far as the east is from the west, so far has He  
removed our transgressions from us.

## MARCH SCRIPTURE – PSALM 62: 1-2, 5-12

- <sup>1</sup> Truly my soul silently waits for God; from Him  
alone comes my salvation.
- <sup>2</sup> He only is my rock and my salvation; He is my  
defense; I shall not be greatly moved.
- <sup>5</sup> My soul, wait silently for God alone,  
for my expectation is from Him.
- <sup>6</sup> He only is my rock and my salvation;  
He is my defense;  
I shall not be moved.
- <sup>7</sup> In God is my salvation and my glory;  
the rock of my strength,  
and my refuge, is in God.
- <sup>8</sup> Trust in Him at all times, you people;  
pour out your heart before Him;  
God is a refuge for us.
- <sup>9</sup> Surely men of low degree are a vapor,  
men of high degree are a lie;  
if they are weighed on the scales,  
they are altogether lighter than vapor.
- <sup>10</sup> Do not trust in oppression,  
nor vainly hope in robbery;  
if riches increase,  
do not set your heart on them.
- <sup>11</sup> God has spoken once,  
twice I have heard this:  
That power belongs to God.
- <sup>12</sup> Also to You, O Lord, belongs mercy;  
for You render to each one according to his work.

## APRIL SCRIPTURE – PSALM 96: 1-10

- 1 Oh, sing to the LORD a new song!  
Sing to the LORD, all the earth.
- 2 Sing to the LORD, bless His name;  
proclaim the good news of His salvation from  
day to day.
- 3 Declare His glory among the nations,  
His wonders among all peoples.
- 4 For the LORD is great and greatly to be praised;  
He is to be feared above all gods.
- 5 For all the gods of the peoples are idols,  
but the LORD made the heavens.
- 6 Honor and majesty are before Him;  
strength and beauty are in His sanctuary.
- 7 Give to the LORD, O families of the peoples,  
give to the LORD glory and strength.
- 8 Give to the LORD the glory due His name;  
bring an offering, and come into His courts.
- 9 Oh, worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness!  
Tremble before Him, all the earth.
- 10 Say among the nations, “The LORD reigns; the  
world also is firmly established, it shall not be  
moved; He shall judge the peoples righteously.”

## MAY SCRIPTURE – PSALM 119: 9 -11, 97-105

- 9 How can a young man cleanse his way?  
By taking heed according to Your word.
- 10 With my whole heart I have sought You; Oh, let me  
not wander from Your commandments!
- 11 Your word I have hidden in my heart,  
that I might not sin against You.
- 97 Oh, how I love Your law!  
It is my meditation all the day.
- 98 You, through Your commandments,  
make me wiser than my enemies;  
for they are ever with me.
- 99 I have more understanding than all my teachers,  
for Your testimonies are my meditation.
- 100 I understand more than the ancients,  
because I keep Your precepts.
- 101 I have restrained my feet from every evil way,  
that I may keep Your word.
- 102 I have not departed from Your judgments,  
for You Yourself have taught me.
- 103 How sweet are Your words to my taste,  
sweeter than honey to my mouth!
- 104 Through Your precepts I get understanding;  
Therefore I hate every false way.
- 105 Your word is a lamp to my feet  
And a light to my path.
